## Youth Membership Requirements

To utilize the equipment provided by the North County Recreation Center, your child must become a member of the Recreation Center. Registration is FREE. Your child will need to have a completed application on file with:

1. Child's contact information
2. Parents contact information
3. Name of school the child is attending
4. Two emergency contacts
5. Signed Rules of Conduct Form by child and parent



Child must continue to obey the rules of the Recreation Center or may have equipment use privileges revoked and if behavior problems persist your child could be expelled from use of the Recreation Center.

#### Special Events

#### Lunch & Snack Programs

**LUNCH-** During the summer months NCRPD provides a nutritious lunch at the NCRC and at the El Cerrito Apartments in the Moro Cojo Housing Community. Lunch is served Monday thru Friday to kids 2 to 18 years old at noon. Please call to see start and end dates each year.

**SNACK-** Throughout the year NCRC provide a nutritious snack for children ages 2 to 18. Snack is served Monday thru Friday at 4pm in the Meeting Room at the North County Recreation Center.

**There is no cost to either the lunch or snack programs.**

### FUNiversity

We provide an even more organized structure compared to our drop-in programs. NCRC Staff will pick up your child from Castroville School or meet them as they get off the bus from Prunedale School. FUNiversity has a nominal fee, but provides additional services for your child.

### Skate Club

If your child enjoys skateboarding, they can sign-up to be a part of our Skate Club. Skate Club members can earn points that can be redeemed for skateboard gear or apparel. Not only is it the law, but we require that all skateboarders wear a helmet while at the North County Recreation Center. Please help us keep your child safe and reinforce that they wear their helmet while skating.
